Operating Conditions That Must Be Followed When Using This Permit

- 1) All operators must abide by seasonal, all bridge, or other special posting limits at all times. This includes any newly posted limits after the permit was issued.
- 2) Permit may be displayed electronically either on a screen of sufficient size to present a readable copy or by emailing an electronic copy of the permit to law enforcement upon request. If operator does not have electronic means of presentation, a paper copy of the permit must be in the permitted IOH or Ag-CMV.
- 3) Issuance of a permit is not a guarantee of the sufficiency of any roadway or structure for the movement of the vehicles authorized by the IOH/Ag-CMV permit. The operator or the owner of the vehicle must determine that the route of travel is open and adequate for the permitted vehicle or vehicles at the time of operation. Application for and acceptance of this permit means that the owner or lessees of the equipment is responsible for any damage to bridges, culverts, pavement, private property, public property, wires, or other overhead obstructions on route and will compensate the maintenance authority and/or property owner for damage done as a result of operation of the permitted vehicle or vehicles. Permittee will hold the local maintaining authority, its subdivisions, officers, employees and agents harmless from any claim which may arise from operation over public highways.
- 4) This permit authorizes operation only on the specifically approved roads of the local maintaining authority. Operation on any other municipal, town or county roads must be authorized by the maintenance authority for those roads.
- 5) If routes shown on the permit are blocked or impeded by construction that occurs during the duration of the permit, please contact the issuing Local Maintaining Authority.
