HIGHLIGHTS:

- 1 - City of Monroe is reduced from 10 to 9 supervisors.
- 2 - 11 Towns have been kept intact, up from 9 previously.
- 3 - 2 Towns went from 2 supervisory districts to 3 supervisory districts. (Exeter, Brooklyn)
- 4 - 1351 is Highest population district - Spring Grove/Decatur at +14
- 5 - 1018 is Lowest population district - village of Albany at -14
- 6 - Difference between largest and smallest is 333 people.
- 7 - 20 (2/3) of all districts are within the target + or - 5% guide.
- 8 - Remaining 11 (1/3) of districts retain village, town or ward boundaries to make redistricting easier and less expensive for municipalities and elections.
