 - Individuals are continuing to make progress at their own pace.
 - We currently have 12 individuals in Drug Court
 - 7 males/5 females
 - There are 5 individuals in Phase I
 - There are 4 individuals in Phase II
 - There are 2 individuals in Phase III
 - There is 1 individual in Phase VI
 - There is a total of 5 phases throughout the Drug Court Program.
 - Discussion of Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) and what that entails.
 - Currently, 7 of the 12 individuals in Drug Court are on MAT.
 - The Drug Court Team just returned from the WATCP (Wisconsin Association of Treatment Court Professionals) conference held in Pewaukee, WI April 18-20.
 - Next training: Coordinator's Conference located in Steven's Point September 19 and 20 (Whitney).
