1. Verified that door is unlocked.
2. Meeting called to order @ 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Richard Thoman. Motion to approve minutes of the previous regular meeting by Calvin Wickline; 2nd by Joe Snow. Motion Carried.
3. **Review Emergency Management updates;** Sheriff Rohloff informed the committee that there will be a full scale exercise on November 7th in Brodhead. Sheriff Rohloff updated the committee that the department had the drone at the Badger State Ethanol Plant for the silo fire and the building that collapsed earlier this week.
4. **Review EMS updates;** Sheriff Rohloff advised that the next Green Co. EMS Association meeting will be hosted by the Sheriff's Department at the Justice Center at 7:00 p.m.
5. **Review and updates on Radio System:** Chief Deputy Thomas Moczynski advised that the Radio Ad Hoc Committee has been meeting with the consultants and hopefully, will finish the Request for Proposal draft at their next meeting on October 18th. Chief Deputy Moczynski indicated that if the ad hoc committee approves the draft that they will hopefully have for the November meeting.
6. **Training Requests:** Sheriff Rohloff had the following training requests;
 - 1) A detective to attend death investigation training in Milwaukee, WI, with five overnights and a registration cost of \$595.00;
 - 2) A sergeant to attend Badger Tracs user conference in WI Dells, with one overnight and a registration cost of \$60.00;
 - 3) Two employees to attend the Time Agency Coordinator course in Brown County with one overnight and free registration;

Sherri Fiduccia made a motion to approve the training; 2nd by Calvin Wickline. Motion Carried.
7. **Review Jail Population and jail medical issues:** Sheriff Rohloff discussed the state of the department. The jail housed an average of 43 inmates for September and the population has been in the upper 40's.
8. **Review and approve Public Safety and Department updates;** Sheriff Rohloff updated the committee that he has a conditional offer of employment to a dispatcher contingent on her passing the physical and drug screen and then there is one vacancy in dispatch yet to fill. Sheriff Rohloff informed the committee that a former employee passed away and there is an employee out on Family Medical Leave.
12. **Review monthly Budget:** Each committee member received a copy of the August budget and the department is currently on track.

13. Audit bills: The Department Bills were reviewed and signed. A motion was made by Calvin Wickline and seconded by Joe Snow to approve the bills. Motion carried.

13. Next Meeting: Next meeting date is on Wednesday, November 14, 2018, at 9:30 a.m. Joe Snow moved to adjourn and Sherri Fiduccia seconded. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 9:55 a.m. by Chairman Thoman.
